Gluten Free Hosts for those suffering from Celiac disease.

We have low-gluten hosts available. The Vatican is reminding priests and laypeople that the hosts must “contain a sufficient amount of gluten to obtain the confection of bread without the addition of foreign materials and without the use of procedures that would alter the nature of bread” in order to stay true to the sacrament of the Eucharist. While gluten – a protein composite – is a necessary ingredient, there are always options. We don’t want anyone to not receive the Eucharist who wants it. The low-gluten hosts are sealed and consecrated separately to prevent cross-contamination. Please call the parish office or speak to Father prior to Mass.
