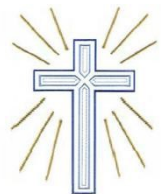

HEARING THE WORD:

Jesus said: "To what shall we compare the kingdom of God, or what parable can we use for it? It is like a mustard seed that, when it is sown in the ground, is the smallest of all the seeds on the earth. But once it is sown, it springs up and becomes the largest of plants and puts forth large branches, so that the birds of the sky can dwell in its shade."

REFLECTING ON THE WORD: Nothing about Jesus' birth in the manger seemed to herald the king of heaven and earth. But from that humble beginning came a faith that changed everything. Power does not emanate from size or outward muscle but from a quality that is within the individual, If Jesus had allowed the stable to define him he may have never had the courage to enter his full ministry He knew that context is merely a backdrop for the full story yet to be written.

What big things do you want to do?*

LIVING THE WORD: Ask each family member: what are the small things about each other that go unnoticed but are vital to the families well-being? Look around the house, or somewhere in nature and seek out small items and discuss how these small things affect our world in a large way.
