I have been blessed to witness the strength of our community, the kindness of your hearts, and the depth of your faith. You have taught me the true meaning of fellowship and the power of prayer. I will carry these lessons with me always.

Hubert Luken was one of the first parishioners that I met here at St. John Bosco in April 2017. He used to attend, serve and lead hymns for the daily masses. When he learned of my mum's birthday which is on 11th October, he told me that I should call him maternal uncle as his birthday as well as the year are the same as my mum. The fun, the laughter, the noise, and the drama, will be greatly missed by me in the coming months and years.

A few times I heard "your homily today went directly to my heart," when I least prepared myself, I knew it was the work of the Holy Spirit that filled that gap. After every funeral, there was someone from the pew who would say, "the service was good", it helped me to reflect on my own death and resurrection. When a little child called me "Father Jesus" I would ask myself, if I am worthy even to be called so. The generosity of so many of our great volunteers from our parish community made my work and life much easier. The few challenges that I faced for the past eight years helped me to grow as a person and as a pastor.

You have taught me so much about what it means to be a Christian community: your resilience, your compassion, and your unwavering trust in God's plan. I have been truly blessed to witness your faith in action, whether it's been through your service to those in need, your vibrant ministries, or simply your presence in the pews each Sunday.

I will carry a piece of St. John Bosco parish with me always, and you will remain in my daily prayers. While it's sad to say goodbye, I am also filled with hope for the future of this parish. I pray that you will continue to grow in holiness, to deepen your relationship with Christ, and to be a welcoming home for all who seek Him.

#### PARISH REGISTRATION

Have you registered with the parish? Have you moved? Please make sure you are registered and that your contact information is up to date. Parish registration is important for these reasons:

- •Celebration of the Sacraments – we require you to be registered in order to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage, or to have your child baptised/celebrate their first reconciliation, communion or confirmation
- •To support you with pastoral letters, documentation, or refugee sponsorship. If you need a letter to have your child baptised in another parish or any other documentation, you will need to have been registered in our parish for at least six months
- •To communicate with you and to know who is a part of our community, so we can support our parishioners better
- •To easily be able to prepare tax receipts for donations to the parish. Donations to the parish are the only way that we pay our bills and provide pastoral and spiritual services. We truly appreciate all contributions to our parish. Please consider using automatic monthly bank withdrawal or donation envelopes if you are not already
