Father Chinnapparaj Balraj, a Salesian of Don Bosco from Tamilnadu, South India was born on 29th December 1979. He became a Salesian on 24th May 1999. He did his schooling from the 6th grade with the Salesians and fascinated by the life and charism of St. John Bosco, he felt the God's call while doing his 8th grade and he entered the Salesian aspirantate for his initial Seminary formation and kept growing positively by the motivation and the guidance of Salesians, with the blessings of Lord Jesus and Blessed Mother Mary. Studies of Philosophy was done at the Salesian Institute, Yercaud and Theology at Ecclesiastical institution of the the Archdiocese of Madras-Mylapore, both affiliated to Rome. He was ordained a priest on 26th December 2009.



He has two university degrees on two various disciplines namely, Sociology and History and a master's degree in History, he also has qualified himself with a special degree on School Education in order to be a teacher in the School. He has served the Church as Associate Pastor, School teacher, Youth Director, Social work Coordinator, Administrator at various parishes and Salesian institutions in Tamilnadu. He has served as Vocation Director for the Salesians in Tamilnadu for 3 years and he has served as the Administrator and School Teacher at the St. Mary's School, Fujairah, United Arab Emirates (UAE). May 2024, he arrived in Edmonton, Canada and served as Associate pastor at St. Charles Parish. 1st July 2025, he took charge as administrator of St. John Bosco Church.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Have you registered with the parish? Have you moved? Please make sure you are registered and that your contact information is up to date. Parish registration is important for these reasons:

•Celebration of the Sacraments – we require you to be registered in order to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage, or to have your child baptised/celebrate their first reconciliation, communion or confirmation

•To support you with pastoral letters, documentation, or refugee sponsorship. If you need a letter to have your child baptised in another parish or any other documentation, you will need to have been registered in our parish for at least six months

•To communicate with you and to know who is a part of our community, so we can support our parishioners better

•To easily be able to prepare tax receipts for donations to the parish. Donations to the parish are the only way that we pay our bills and provide pastoral and spiritual services. We truly appreciate all contributions to our parish. Please consider using automatic monthly bank withdrawal or donation envelopes if you are not already
